



CAMP WAR EAGLE PACKING LIST



Listed below are items that are needed for Camp War Eagle. **Please note that NO item is mandatory.** If you are unable to supply an item due to your financial situation, Camp War Eagle can provide any essential items needed during the camp session. Laundry service is provided once during each 14 day overnight session. Laundry service can also be available on an as-needed basis for overnight campers unable to provide enough clothing for the session.

PACKING TIPS

- Many overnight campers pack in a trunk or container that fits under their bunk (about 15" tall).
- Day campers should bring items daily in a backpack.
- Some campers enjoy having a book to read or a deck of cards to play with at rest period.
- Remember that **all overnight** camper medications will be checked into the Health Center, so they should **not** be packed in your camper's luggage.
- Campers are not allowed to have money in the cabins. Any money found during session will be deposited into their Camper Store Account.
- Camp War Eagle provides all necessary equipment for activities; therefore, it is not necessary to bring ball gloves, tennis racquets, skateboards, bikes, etc. Expensive cameras should not be brought.
- Don't send your camper's nicest clothes to camp! Choose everyday, comfortable clothing and shoes.

NOT ALLOWED

- Girls should not bring backless shirts, halter tops, or any low cut, tight, or exposing material.
- Two-piece swimsuits for females are not allowed. One-piece, modest swimsuits are required for all female campers and staff at Camp War Eagle. If it is necessary for Camp War Eagle to replace a camper's swimsuit that does not meet this requirement, the camper's store account may be charged for the cost of a replacement swimsuit.
- Clothing displaying profanity or inappropriate content is prohibited.
- Radios, iPods, CD players, MP3 players, cell phones, laptops, video games, and other similar items are not allowed. If these items are brought to camp, they will be confiscated and held in a secure location until the camper's departure.
- Fireworks, guns, ammunition, knives, and/or other weapons are not allowed.
- Food, gum or candy is prohibited in the cabins and must not be sent or brought to camp.
- Pets or animals of any kind may not be brought to camp.

In order to assure safety and security, Camp War Eagle reserves the right to search all personal belongings at any time.

Camp War Eagle is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
