The Staff Recruiter's Responsibilities

Staff Recruiting

- Travel to colleges across Texas in the early fall through spring to interview staff.
- Prepare for college campuses by gathering lists and scheduling announcements.
- Visit college campuses to recruit summer staff.
- Conduct screening of potential summer staff to ensure the best employees end up working at Camp OTX.
- Engage with summer staff throughout the year to increase staff retention.

Administrative Duties

- Be able to understand and conduct basic computer tasks.
- Be proficient in Microsoft Excel, Microsoft Word, and understand how to manage and organize a shared Google Drive.
- Implementation of summer program from planning, training, and execution.

Summer Operations

- Assist in supervision of staff and campers' safety during summer.
- Supervise a program area during the summer program.
- Implement summer program from planning, to training, to execution.
- Supervise designated cabin areas for the best experience of our camper and staff.
- Supervise staff over the course of the summer and conduct evaluations with them.
- Be a part of the Staff Relations team.
