Qualifications

- Current CPR Certification.
- One year experience as a Camp War Eagle summer staff

Responsibilities

Camp War Eagle HC Intern duties include but are not limited to:

- Assisting and/or observing HC provider in procedures as qualified per school program requirements
- Assisting medical staff in maintaining inpatient quarters
- Nursing students may operate under the supervision of registered medical staff as outlined by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing
- Assisting medical staff in the screening of campers for communicable diseases on arrival
- Assisting medical staff in the implementation of health care plan
- Promotion of preventative measures
- Attending special nighttime events and giving minor first aid as certified
- Implementation of Universal Precautions
 - Uses good hand washing or antibacterial gel between campers.
 - o Proper handling of blood born pathogens
 - Uses CPR barrier if indicated
- Having a current certification in CPR and AED training

General Requirements

- Willingness to comply with all Camp War Eagle policies and procedures during employment.
- Willingness to comply with all state and federal laws.
- Minimum of 5 years of experience as a Registered Nurse in an applicable clinical setting with experience caring for both the adult and pediatric population.
