Responsibilities

Camp War Eagle Physician duties include but are not limited to:

- Administration and documentation of over the counter medications and treatments to campers
- Identification, treatment and documentation of routine health needs
- Implementation of health care plan
- Promotion of preventative measures
- Responding to emergencies
- Transporting of campers to outside medical facilities if appropriate
- Staying with a camper in the hospital setting
- Attending special nighttime events and giving minor first aid
- Supervising and caring for in-patients
- Implementation of Universal Precautions
 - Uses good hand washing or antibacterial gel between campers.
 - Proper handling of blood born pathogens
 - Uses CPR barrier if indicated
- Having a current certification in CPR and AED training

- Able to assist campers and staff members in the Camp War Eagle Program
- Able to demonstrate sensitivity to the needs of campers and staff members
- Able to model Christ-like love to campers and staff members
- Able to follow directions
- Able to function in a fast-paced, non-air-conditioned environment
