DRESS CODE

We are so excited to have you be a part of the Camp War Eagle summer staff. As you prepare for the summer, we would like to give you vision for what we ask when it comes to our dress code and why we do what we do:

EVERYONE

- We expect you to dress modestly, keeping in mind that you are a role model for young and impressionable campers who are from 6-17 years old.
- Acceptable piercings include those in the ears and nose that are small in nature; smaller hoops are acceptable for ears but small studs for nose piercings are required.
- Staff may not have clothing or tattoos that exhibit or allude to alcohol, tobacco, profanity, offensive symbols, or sex.

- Clothing must be modest and not revealing (no two pieces or halter top swimsuits, crop tops, tube tops, or extra short shorts)
